Population



- Treasure Coast, Fl (treasurecoast.com) – The Treasure Coast saw substantial population growth in the last decade, according to a batch of 2020 data released last Thursday afternoon by the U.S. Census Bureau.
- The growth is among other trends gleaned from the census, an official count of the U.S. population as of April 1, 2020, gathered from questionnaires. The data shows race, ethnicity, housing occupancy, and population changes.
- The total population grows in Treasure Coast counties
- Martin County: Nearly 8.3% population increase, from nearly 147,000 to 158,000 residents. The county trailed Indian River and St. Lucie in the percentage of population growth over the last decade.
- St. Lucie County: Over 18.5% population increase, from nearly 278,000 to 329,000 residents. The county outpaced Martin and Indian River counties.
- Indian River County: Nearly 15.8% population increase, from 138,000 to 160,000 residents. The population grew more than in Martin County but less than in St. Lucie County.
- The data helps businesses track population growth to figure out where to open shop, expand existing enterprises or recruit workers.
- Data previously released in April by the U.S. Census Bureau is used for reapportionment, the process that determines how many representatives to the U.S. House are given to each state based on population.





Climate and Weather

Treasure Coast in Florida: Enjoy the sub-tropical climate!

In much of Florida, the climate is sub-tropical, with mild winters (but subject to short cold spells) and hot, sunny summers. Summer, from June to September, is also muggy and with frequent thunderstorms.

In summer, temperatures are uniform from north to south, especially in the daytime, when they range between 31 °C and 33 °C (88 °F and 91 °F), while at night, they become warmer as you head south, in fact, they range from 21 °C (70 °F) in the far north to 27 °C (81 °F) in the Keys.

In winter, there are on average 8/9 days with rainfall in the north and 6/7 in the center-south. The rains are due to frontal systems, which are formed because of the clash of air masses, and may be accompanied by the wind, and sometimes by cold temperatures. The rare cold spells can occur from late November to mid-March.

06 CHECKLIST

Follow this checklist to ensure that you are prepared for your move.

With the excitement of moving, it can also be frustrating and stressful. Whether you are moving because of a job transfer, downsizing, relocating, or buying your first home.

Tips



REMINDER

- *Make sure your banking institution is aware if you are moving out of state so that your credit or debit cards stay on.*
- *If applicable, get kids' school records and immunization records if you have school-age children.*
- *Take pictures before you disassemble items, especially electronics. Make notes so you can quickly reconnect them later.*
- *Tape doors on cabinets or other furniture closed due to moving.*
- *Use air bubble wrap and shock-absorbing foam to avoid breaking your glass items.*



REMINDER

- Make sure medical records are transferred to your New doctor's Office.
- Keep your valuables; jewelry, wills, financial documents, insurance papers together and personally take those items with you.
- If you are selling your home Do not turn off Utilities prior to Settlement.
- Take Inventory, know exactly how many boxes and items the movers are taking. Use the inventory checklist.
- Label and Number the boxes and add what room it will go in.

Moving Timeline

8 weeks before you move!

☐

CREATE A BUDGET

How much would it cost to move; moving supplies: boxes, tape, bubble wrap, truck, and labor.

☐

BEFORE YOU PACK A SINGLE BOX

Take inventory of your belongings if you are looking to downsize or need to declutter. Consider having a yard sale, donating unwanted items to a local non-profit, salvation army, or you can sell your items online using the Facebook marketplace, Craigslist, or you may want to auction collectibles.

☐

GET THE MOVING TEAM READY:

Our team can assist you with this if needed. Call and book your moving Truck and arrange for your moving helpers early. Make sure they are licensed and bonded. Booking early could avoid paying higher fees, especially during peak seasons.

☐

LET'S START PACKING:

Preparing and starting early is the best option. This way, you are not rushed. Start with one room at a time. Label all boxes (see printable labels)

4 weeks before you move!

☐

CONTACT AND SCHEDULE WITH SERVICE PROVIDERS:

Call the utility, internet, cable, and security company to transfer service to your new home. Also, contact your current service providers to close out your account.

☐

CHANGE OF ADDRESS:

Visit or go online to submit a change of address with your local post office. Contact your bank, and all your creditors; car, credit card, insurance companies. Notify your human resource office for a change of address for your payroll and or tax documents.

☐


NOTIFY AND CANCEL LOCAL NEWSPAPERS AND OTHER REGULAR DELIVERY SERVICES:

Transfer magazine and newspaper subscriptions, water services. If you are changing banks, make sure you contact your banking institution to make arrangements to remove items from safe deposit boxes.

☐

PLANNING SCHOOL TRANSFER

If you have school-age children, arrange for their school records to be transferred to their new school district.

2 days before you move!

- ☐ **LAST-MINUTE CHECK-UP**
Ensure everything is ready for the movers and put your Essentials aside from what the movers will be taking.
- ☐ **MAKE SURE YOUR VEHICLE IS OPERABLE**
If you are driving to your new home, make sure you have checked your vehicle; oil change, tune-up, and air pressure for tires.

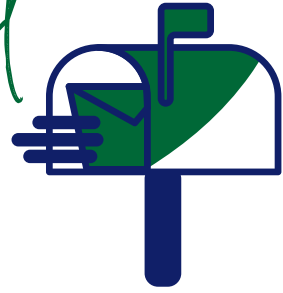

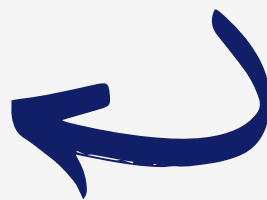
